

2025 Impact Report

Tampa Bay Abortion Fund

TBAFund removes financial and logistical barriers to abortion access. We specifically assist pregnant people seeking abortion in Hillsborough and Pinellas Counties.

We also provide funding assistance and practical/travel support at numerous out-of-state clinics for Floridians over six-weeks of pregnancy, due to unnecessary abortion restrictions in Florida.

In 2025, TBAFund spent:

\$935,000 total on support for abortion-seekers

\$860,000
towards abortion clinic appointment funding

\$75,000
on practical/travel support to get abortion-seekers to their appointments

Through TBAFund's intake:

4,017 abortion-seekers reached out for support navigating their barriers.

3,133 abortion-seekers received funding support from TBAFund*

*TBAF follows-up with everyone who reaches out for support. The 884 callers who did not receive funding from TBAF were either: redirected to an abortion fund in their service area, given appropriate referrals for their individual needs, received additional funding from national programs, or we were unable to get ahold of them for follow-up.

In 2025, TBAFund supported funding at:

9
abortion clinics in the Greater Tampa Bay Area, for abortion-seekers under six-weeks of pregnancy.

22
abortion clinics outside Florida, for abortion-seekers over six-weeks of pregnancy. (Supported states include DC, IL, MD, NC, NJ, NM, NY, OH, PA, and VA.)

In 2025, TBAFund saw the following averages:

Average monthly spending on abortion appointment costs: **\$70,000**

\$350
Average funding for clinic costs, per client.

\$640
Average spent on practical/travel support, per person.**




How TBAF received funding in 2025:

Grant Funding Restrictions:

- ▶ Operating Expenses – 4%
- ▶ Other programs – 18%
- ▶ Staffing – 36%
- ▶ Abortion Care & Practical Support – 42%



74% of TBAF's funds were spent on funding **abortion care and practical/travel support**, in 2025.

Through TBAFund's outreach program:
